

## HOW TO READ YOUR SCHEDULE!!

The following are some tips on how to understand your schedule that you received in your registration folder. I hope this will be helpful and as always do not be afraid to ask questions. Starting from left going to the **right-**

1. **Time of Day:** The junior high day is made up of 10 periods. These periods are listed under the Time of Day heading on the far left of your schedule. Period 6, for example is lunch while period 10 is homeroom.
2. **Semester:** Classes in junior high are assigned by semester. There is Semester 1 and Semester 2. Semester 3 is used to designate lunch and homeroom. Semesters are listed under the Sem heading on your schedule. You have your core classes (P.E., Social Studies, English, Language Arts, Science, and Math) both first and second semester. Your exploratory classes will most likely change after the first semester. Exploratory classes are held during the first two periods of the day. For example, you will have health one semester and another class the other semester.
3. **Terms-** The heading terms just indicates which quarters you will have the class. A first semester class meets during the **first** and second quarter. A second semester class meets during the **third** and fourth quarters.
4. **Days-** You only need to be concerned about this column for periods 1 and 2 as all core classes and lunch meet everyday. Exploratory classes meet on an every other day basis. These days are known as "1" days and "2" days. The first day of school is a "1" day. The next day is a "2" day while the following day will again be a "1" day. We post in different areas of the school which day it is. A student may have choir on a "1" day and health on a "2" day.
5. The rest of the schedule tells the name of the course, the teacher, and room number. Below is an example of how to read the schedule.

(Period) Time of day	Sem	Terms	Days	Course Description

The above student has JH keyboarding first period of the day, first semester on "1" days. The student has Study Hall the first period of the day, first semester on "2" days.

They have Health first period, second semester on "1" days and Careers first period, second semester on "2" days. Period 2 follows the same format.
