

Dear Parent or Guardian:

The Illinois School Code requires the following information for preschool, kindergarten, sixth grade, ninth grade and transfer students upon entry to school:

1. A current physical exam, recorded on the approved form, and signed by a physician, advanced practice nurse or physician's assistant. The form must be signed in three places. The **Health History Section** must be completed and signed by a parent or guardian.
2. A complete record of immunization dates your child received for diphtheria, tetanus, pertussis, polio, measles, mumps, rubella, Heb B, Hib (preschool/kindergarten only), and varicella vaccine (proof of disease history is accepted). A Lead screening is required for students entering preschool and kindergarten. A Diabetes screening is required for preschool, kindergarten, fifth and ninth grades. The records must be signed by the health care provider who gave the immunization or can verify those dates of immunizations.

The following is a checklist to insure completed and accurate health records:

- _____ **My Child Received a Physical Examination** upon entering preschool, kindergarten, sixth, ninth grade or transferring from out of state. To be current, the physical must be dated within one year of school entrance in the year it is required.
- _____ **Immunizations are Up to Date** (see immunization guidelines attachment.)
- _____ The physical has a **Doctor's signature**.
- _____ **The Health History Section** of the physical is completed, signed, and dated.
- _____ **A Dental Exam** was conducted and the dental form was completed and signed by the Dentist. Required for students entering kindergarten, second, and sixth grades.
- _____ **A Lead Screening** was conducted and recorded on the physical. For preschool and kindergarten students only.
- _____ **A Diabetes Screening** was conducted and recorded on the physical. Required for students entering preschool, kindergarten, fifth and ninth grades.

Since compliance with these requirements is most important for the health of your student and all of our students and staff, Durand School District 322 will not allow your student to attend school if requirements are not met by the October 15th deadline.
